



Cub Scout Camping Checklist (What to Bring)



- Tent & tent pegs/stakes
- Tent Broom
- Tarp for under Tent
- Sleeping Bags
- Air mattress, Cot, Sleeping pad
- Pillows
- **Bug Repellant**
- Sun Screen
- Lantern
- Flash Light
- Folding Chairs (Handy around the campfire)
- Long fork or hangers for roasting marshmallows
- Small tools hammer, wrench
- **Plastic cups, plates, utensils, bowls that you can reuse – “Green Camping”**
- Coffee mugs
- Rain gear – poncho recommended
- Sweatshirt and/or Jacket
- Hats
- Towels and washcloth
- Personal items & toiletries
- BOOKS (Tree / Bird Identification or Other)
- Cub Scout Handbooks
- Camera & film
- Good Attitude :)

Pocketknife – **Only** Cub scouts who have earned their *whittling chip* and are supervised by a parent are allowed to have knives.

NOTE: Leave Your Pets At Home!

Camping Rules;

1. No Gameboys or other electronic devices
2. No toy guns, swords, etc.
3. No Running in camp.
4. No open toed shoes (ex. sandals, flip-flops).
5. No Croc's (These do not provide support if stepping on something sharp).

7. No Camouflage clothing
8. No alcohol
